is pleased to offer assessment services to the students of our school community. For students ages 6-16, a comprehensive assessment battery using the Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children-IV (WISC-IV) and the Wechsler Individual Achievement Test-III (WIAT-III) is available to identify strengths and weaknesses in problem solving, processing and academic skills. For students over age 16, the Wechsler

Abbreviated Scales of Intelligence (WASI) is available to update previous evaluation results obtained from a comprehensive cognitive battery. The WIAT-III is also available for students over age 16. Following interpretation of evaluation results, any necessary accommodations may be developed in order to support academic success and to document eligibility for accommodations on annual school testing and college entrance exams.

Kimberly Harper, M.S. is an Oklahoma State Certified School Psychologist and Educational Diagnostician with over 20 years experience in the field of education

and assessment. Mrs. Harper will conduct assessments for RCDS students, including a written report to parents, reviewing results and generating accommodations as needed.

WIAT-III or WISC-IV only	\$300
WASI only	\$150
