Policies and Procedures

Registration Fee

For Summer only, registration is \$50 for each camper. For new families, Summer and Fall registration is \$150. For returning families, Summer and Fall registration is \$150 by February 28th and \$200 thereafter. The registration fee is a non-refundable annual administrative fee per child.

Deposit

If registering for summer only or summer and fall, include \$200 deposit for each camper. Deposit is deducted from last tuition payment.

Registration/Changes/Cancellations

No refund is given for absences. A \$25 processing fee will be required for any registration change and is dependent upon availability of change. No cancellations are allowed for any Summer Camp after April 1st and full tuition must be paid. **Registration is processed first-come, first-served.**

Camp Tuition Payment Schedule

Tuition is due three times during the summer: May 15th, June 15th, and July 15th. A late fee of 5% of the unpaid balance is charged for payments made after the 25th.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN CAMP

The Pre-Kindergarten Camp is open to children going to Kindergarten in the Fall of 2008. This Camp meets 5 days each week and campers must attend 6 weeks or more (consecutive sessions are preferred for maximum exposure to a topic.)

All children will learn new skills, while being with friends and enjoying discovery camp activities. There are six, two week discovery camps. The camp will be taught by K-1 teacher Ms. Wendy Thompson and Pre-School teacher Mrs. Drew Magova. This will be a fun and exciting camp that all children will love; so please come join us in our discovery camps, while enjoying our beautiful campus!

This camp offers:

- Two week discovery camps – see list below
- Swimming twice a week (weeks 3-12)
- Water play on the splash pad and in sprinklers on campus
- Weekly rotations which will consist of topics including arts and crafts, hiking in the woods, sports and games, cooking, and more
- Frequent half-day field trips
- Sports and activities on the Primary playground and athletic fields
- Shortened afternoon rest times, while participating in MIRP (monitored independent reading practice) and book exploring
- Introduction to the K-1 wing and K-1 teachers, with consistency of 3s-5s teacher who knows the children
