



SNOW DAY POLICY

There are three types of snow events:

1. Late Start: When a late start is declared, classes will begin at 10AM and proceed on the late start schedule. Campus will not be open until 9:45AM.

2. Campus Closed: The school will be closed if the campus cannot be safely prepared for the arrival of employees and students.

3. Cyber Day: After one "Campus Closed" day each semester, virtual learning will be in effect for K - 12th grades. Wing/Division information regarding assignments will be sent out by the Division Head and/or teachers.

For notification of snow day decisions, staff and families will be contacted by email and/or phone via the Parent Alert System.

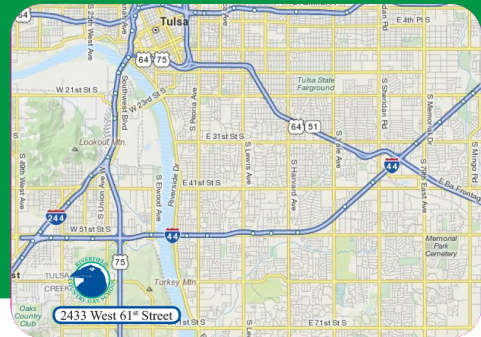
DIRECTIONS TO RIVERFIELD COUNTRY DAY SCHOOL:
